## CHAPTER 29 MEDICAL ASSISTANCE APPROPRIATION

H. F. 128

AN ACT making a supplemental appropriation to the department of social services for medical assistance.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state to the department of social services for the fiscal period beginning with the effective date of this Act and ending June 30, 1977, the sum of eight million (8,000,000) dollars, or so much thereof as is necessary, which shall be used only to supplement existing appropriations for the medical assistance program maintained under chapter two hundred fortynine A (249A) of the Code.

Sec. 2. Any unencumbered or unexpended funds not used for the purpose specified in section one (1) of this Act and remaining on June 30, 1977, shall revert to the general fund of the state. Notwithstanding section eight point thirtynine (8.39) of the Code, funds appropriated by this Act shall not be subject to transfer or expenditure and used for any purpose other than the purpose specified in section one (1) of this Act.

Sec. 3. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Iowa City Press-Citizen, a newspaper published in Iowa City, Iowa, and in The Bancroft Register, a newspaper published in Bancroft, Iowa.
