<u>NEW SECTION</u>. FILING MULTIPLE COUNTS IN ONE INFORMATION, INDICTMENT, OR COMPLAINT. A single information, indictment, or complaint charging false use of a financial instrument may allege more than one such violation against a person. The multiple charges shall be set out in separate counts, and the accused person shall be acquitted or convicted upon each count by a separate verdict. A convicted person shall be sentenced upon each verdict of guilty. The court may consider separate verdicts of guilty returned at the same time as one offense for the purpose of sentencing. Approved June 5, 1978

CHAPTER 1185

CRIMINAL FLIGHT

H. F. 2382

AN ACT relating to flight from the state to avoid prosecution and providing a penalty.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

Section 1. Section seven hundred nineteen point four (719.4), Code 1977 Supplement, is amended by adding the following new subsection:

<u>NEW SUBSECTION</u>. 4. A person who flees from the state to avoid prosecution for a public offense which is a felony or aggravated misdemeanor commits a class D felony.

Sec. 2. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Telegraph Herald, a newspaper published in Dubuque, Iowa, and in The Cedar Rapids Gazette, a newspaper published in Cedar Rapids, Iowa. Approved June 14, 1978
