## CHAPTER 37

## ADULT CORRECTIONAL SECURITY INFORMATION

## H. F. 730

AN ACT exempting certain security information of adult correctional institutions from public disclosure.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

Section 1. Section 68A.7, Code 1981, is amended by adding the following new subsection:

<u>NEW SUBSECTION</u>. Information concerning the procedures to be used to control disturbances at adult correctional institutions. Such information shall also be exempt from public inspection under section 17A.3. As used in this subsection disturbance means a riot or a condition that can reasonably be expected to cause a riot.

## CHAPTER 38 CRIMINAL DATA CONFIDENTIALITY

H. F. 731

AN ACT relating to criminal investigative data, criminal history data, intelligence data, and the confidentiality of peace officers' investigative reports.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

Section 1. Section 68A.7, subsection 5, Code 1981, is amended to read as follows:

5. Peace **efficers** <u>officers</u>' investigative reports, except where disclosure is authorized elsewhere in this Code. <u>However</u>, the date, time, <u>specific location</u>, and <u>immediate facts and circumstances surrounding a crime</u> <u>or incident shall not be kept confidential under this section</u>, <u>except in</u> <u>those unusual circumstances where disclosure would plainly and seriously</u> <u>jeopardize an investigation or pose a clear and present danger to the safety</u> <u>of an individual</u>.

Sec. 2. Section 692.1, Code 1981, is amended by adding the following new subsection:

<u>NEW SUBSECTION</u>. "Criminal investigative data" means information collected in the course of an investigation where there are reasonable grounds to suspect that specific criminal acts have been committed by a person.
