to read as follows: That when any person intends to avail himself of the provisions of chapter 64 of the Code of Iowa, it shall be the duty of such person within ninety days from the time of the performance of the work, Statement to be or of the furnishing of the material, to file in the office ded in Recordof the Recorder and Treasurer of the county in which the premises may be, and to record the same in a book to be provided in each county by the County Judge and kept for that purpose, a statement which shall plainly set forth.

- Any person furnishing materials to be used SEC. 2. in the construction or repair of any building by any contractor or in improving any lot or parcel of ground shall have the same lien as the contractor according to chapter 64 of the Code of Iowa. Provided, That before also furnishing said material, he shall notify in writing the owner or proprietor of the quantity and value of the material to be furnished, and if no objection in writing be made thereto, the owner or proprietor shall pay the said person furnishing the said materials, the value of the same according to the terms and conditions of the contract made with the contractor.
- SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force Take affect. from and after its publication in the Iowa Weekly Citizen and Iowa State Journal.

CHAPTER 40.

REVISION OF THE LAWS.

AN ACT providing for a revision of the laws of Iowa, and the preparation of a Code of Civil and Criminal Procedure.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa, That the Commissioners appointed

com'rs revise by the Legislature to conform the laws of the State to and codify and report by lef of the Constitution and perform other duties, are hereby directed to prepare a code of civil and criminal procedure, and revise and codify the laws of the State and have their report ready for publication by the first day of September, 1858.

SEC. 2. Immediately after filing their report by said Commissioners, the Secretary of State shall procure and distributed to be printed 500 copies of said report, and one month previous to the next session of the General Assembly whether the same be an extra or regular one, shall mail to each member thereof one copy of such printed report and shall retain the residue for the use of the General Assembly.

Take effect.

SEC. 3. This act shall be in force from and after its publication in the Tri-Weekly Iowa Citizen, and Tri-Weekly Iowa State Journal.

STATE UNIVERSITY APPROPRIATION.

AN ACT making appropriation for the State University.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa, That there be and hereby is approprised to state of any money in the State Treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of three thousand dollars for repairing and modifying the building now occupied by the State University of Iowa, and for fitting up one or more rooms thereof for a cabinet to receive the specimens collected and to be collected by the State Geologist and for other cabinets, and the further sum of ten thou-
