CHAPTER 97.

DES MOINES COMMISSIONER.

M ACT appointing a Commissioner to procure the lands granted for improving the navigation of the Des Moines River, to be certified to the State.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa, That Charles Mason, of Des Moines pointed. sounty, is hereby appointed a Commissioner, whose duty it shall be to do all acts in behalf of the State which may be necessary to procure the lands belonging to the grant made to the then Territory of Iowa, by an set of Congress, approved August 8th, 1846, for the Improvement of the Navigation of the Des Moines River, Use offortello proin said Territory, to be certified and set apart to said cure lands. State by the proper Department of the General Govemment, and any act or agreement as to the amount of land to which the State may be entitled under said act of Congress made or concluded by said agent is hereby ratified and confirmed.

Sec. 2. That the State of Iowa shall not be liable state not liable in any manner for any damages growing out of any act ier expense. or agreement of said agent hereby appointed, nor shall the State be held liable for any expense in any manner for the salary or per diem of said agent.

Sec. 3. This act to take effect and be in force im-Take effect. mediately after its puplication in the Iowa State Journal and Iowa Weekly Citizen.
