of the proceeds derived from said trust, or any part thereof, until a final settlement and distribution is made.

SEC. 2. This act shall be in force from and after its publication in the Weekly Citizen and Weekly Journal, papers published in Des Moines, in the State of Iowa. Approved March 22d, 1858.

CHAPTER 113.

SALARIES OF STATE OFFICERS.

AN ACT amendatory of an Act entitled an Act fixing the salaries of the Governor and State Officers of the State of Iowa, approved January 29th, 1857.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa, That the Governor shall receive as a yearly compensation for his services the sum of two thousand dollars.

SEC. 2. The Register of the State Land Office shall receive as a yearly compensation for his services, the sum of fifteen hundred dollars, and their compensation as provided for in this Act shall date from the commencement of the present session of the General Assembly.

SEC. 3. The salaries provided for in this Act shall be paid for quarterly.

SEC. 4. That so much of the Act to which this is acts amendatory as conflicts with the provisions of this Act be and they are hereby repealed.

SEC. 5. This act to take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Iowa Citizen and Iowa State Journal.
