next, after that at which he was elected. All other officers elected by the Senate or House of Representatives, shall hold their offices only during the session, at which they were elected.

SEC. 6. Section eleven of said chapter is hereby re-Repeal.

CHAPTER 127.

APPEARANCE TERM.

AN ACT to amend section 1768, of the Code, and amendatory of the law providing when causes in courts of record shall be tried.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa, That section seventeen hundred and prist term an appearance term. Exty-three of the Code be amended as follows: "except when otherwise provided, causes shall be tried at the second term after they are commenced, unless reasonable cause for a continuance be shown."

SEC. 2. From and after the first day of January, A. Law in force that D. 1859, this act shall cease to be in force, and section seventeen hundred and sixty-three shall be in force and have the effect that the same had previous to the taking effect of this act, provided, that the provisions of section twenty-one (21) of the Code, shall not apply to this act.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force Take effect. from and after its publication in the Iowa Weekly Citizen and Iowa State Journal.
