# CHAPTER 149 <br> TREATMENT OF ANIMALS <br> S.F. 221 

AN ACT relating to treatment of animals by persons licensed or registered under chapter 162 with penalties of license or registration suspension or revocation.

## Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

Section 1. Section 162.13, unnumbered paragraph 2, Code 1983, is amended to read as follows:

Failure of any a person licensed or registered to adequately house, feed, or water dogs or cats, or both, in his or her the person's possession or custody or failure of any an operator of a licensed pet shop to adequately house, feed, or water any a vertebrate animal shall eonstitute is a simple misdemeanor. Sueh animals shall be The animals are subject to seizure and impoundment and may be sold or destroyed by euthanasia at the discretion of the secretary and steh the failure shall is also eonstitute grounds for revocation or suspension of license or registration after public hearing. The commission of an act declared to be an unlawful practice under section 714.16 or chapter 717, by any a person licensed or registered under this chapter shall constitute is grounds for revocation or suspension of the license or registration certificate.

## CHAPTER 150

## GOVERNMENTAL MOTOR FUEL TAX EXEMPTION

S.F. 14

AN ACT to exempt the state, its agencies, and political subdivisions of the state from the tax on motor fuel where the motor fuel is used for a public purpose and delivered into storage tanks owned or used exclusively by the state, its agencies, or a political subdivision of the state.

## Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

Section 1. Section 324.3 , Code 1983 , is amended by adding the following new subsection as subsection 5 immediately following subsection 4:
