

CHAPTER 74
SEX DISCRIMINATION
H.F. 507

AN ACT relating to discrimination by employers and by labor unions, organizations, and officers on the basis of sex, and making a penalty applicable.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

Section 1. Section 729.4, subsections 1 and 2, Code 1987, are amended to read as follows:

1. Every person in this state is entitled to the opportunity for employment on equal terms with every other person. ~~It shall be unlawful for any A~~ person or employer ~~to shall not~~ discriminate in the employment of individuals because of race, religion, color, sex, national origin, or ancestry. However, as to employment ~~such~~ an individual must be qualified to perform the services or work required.

2. ~~It shall be unlawful for any A~~ labor union or organization or an officer thereof ~~to shall~~ not discriminate against any person as to membership therein because of race, religion, color, sex, national origin or ancestry.
