## CHILD ABUSE ASSESSMENT REPORTING

S.F. 303

AN ACT relating to the contents of certain child abuse assessment reports.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

Section 1. Section 232.71B, subsection 11, Code 2003, is amended by adding the following new paragraph:

<u>NEW PARAGRAPH</u>. h. If after completing the assessment process the child protection worker determines, with the concurrence of the worker's supervisor and the department's area administrator, that a report is a spurious report or that protective concerns are not present, the portions of the assessment report described under paragraphs "d" and "e" shall not be required.
