## **CHAPTER 15**

## VEHICULAR TRAFFIC REGULATION — TURNS AGAINST RED LIGHTS $\it H.F.~372$

AN ACT relating to turns against red lights made by vehicular traffic.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

Section 1. Section 321.257, subsection 2, paragraph a, Code 2017, is amended to read as follows:

a. A "steady circular red" light means vehicular traffic shall stop. Vehicular traffic shall remain standing until a signal to proceed is shown or vehicular traffic, unless prohibited by a sign, may cautiously enter the intersection to make a right turn from the right lane of traffic or another lane designated for right turns, or a left turn from a one-way street to a one-way street from the left lane of traffic on a one-way street onto the leftmost lane of traffic on a one-way street or another lane designated for left turns. Turns made under this paragraph shall be made in a manner that does not interfere with other vehicular or pedestrian traffic lawfully using the intersection. Pedestrian traffic facing a steady circular red light shall not enter the roadway unless the pedestrian can safely cross the roadway without interfering with any vehicular traffic.
