## **CHAPTER 1141**

## HUNTING OR TRAPPING — PERSONS UNDER SIXTEEN YEARS OF AGE ACCOMPANYING AN ADULT

H.F. 2209

AN ACT relating to residents under sixteen years of age accompanying an adult who is hunting or trapping.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

Section 1. Section 483A.24, subsection 9, Code 2022, is amended to read as follows:

9. A resident of the state under sixteen years of age is not required to have a <u>hunting or</u> fur harvester license to accompany the minor's parent or guardian, or any other competent adult with the consent of the minor's parent or guardian, while the parent or guardian or other adult is hunting <u>raceoons</u> <u>or trapping any game or fur-bearing animal</u> so long as the minor is not hunting or trapping and does not carry or use a firearm or any other weapon.
