CHAPTER 154.

TREASURER'S CERTIFICATES.

AN ACT to protect owners of Treasurers' Certificates of purchase of Real Estate at Tax Sales.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa*, That the owner of a Treasurer's Certificate of purchase of lands in this State, now or hereafter sold for taxes, may recover damages by suit in his own name, of any person committing waste or trespass thereon, as provided in sections 2134 and 2137 of the Revision of 1860. Damages for waste or trespass on lands.

SEC. 2. All moneys collected under the provisions of this Act shall be paid, by the officer collecting the same, to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of the County in which the waste or trespass was committed, which moneys shall be held by said Clerk, and an entry thereof made in a book to be kept by him for that purpose, until the lands upon which such waste or trespass was committed, shall have been redeemed or a Treasurer's deed therefor shall have been executed and delivered to the holder of said certificate, when if redemption be made, the money shall be paid the owner of the land, and if not redeemed, to the tax sale purchaser or his assignee.
