Chairman Sands called the meeting to order at 9:58 AM.

The committee stood at ease at 9:59 AM for both parties to caucus.

The committee reconvened at 10:50 AM.

Roll call was taken and a quorum was present.

As there were no corrections, amendments and/or deletions to the April 2nd meeting minutes, they were unanimously approved.

Chairman Sands recognized Representative Moore for opening remarks on SF 386. An Act relating to matters under the purview of the department of transportation, including the use of information contained in electronic driver and nonoperator identification records, the form of motor vehicle financial liability coverage cards, motor truck registration periods, grounds for disqualification of commercial vehicle operators, provisions for the issuance of temporary restricted licenses for persons convicted of operating while intoxicated, county issuance of driver's licenses, and the administration of highway contracts. The chair recognized Representative Moore for Amendment 1285. The amendment was moved and passed on short form. The bill as amended was moved and passed by the vote of 24 Aye, 0 Nay and 1 Absent. The bill will move to the house floor as a Senate File as amended.

Chairman Sands recognized Representative Byrnes for opening remarks on SF 371. An Act

providing for special vehicle registration plates displaying a decal designed and issued by a nonprofit organization, providing fees, and making a penalty applicable. The bill was moved and passed by the vote 24 Aye, 0 Nay and 1 Absent. The bill will move to the house floor as a Senate File.

Chairman Sands recognized Representative Byrnes for opening remarks on SF 146. An Act extending a provision relating to the use of certain increases in watercraft registration fees by the natural resource commission. The bill was moved and passed by the vote 24 Aye, 0 Nay and 1 Absent. The bill will move to the house floor as a Senate File.

Chairman Sands recognized Representative Maxwell for opening remarks on HF 511. An Act exempting certain farm real estate from the inheritance tax, and including applicability provisions. The chair recognized Representative Maxwell for Amendment 1451. The amendment was moved and passed on short form. The bill as amended was moved and passed by the vote 21 Aye, 3 Nay and 0 Absent. The nay vote were Representatives Oldson, Isenhardt and Kelly. The bill will move to the house floor as a committee file as amended.

Chairman Sands recognized Representative Moore for opening remarks on HSB 230. An Act establishing a property tax exemption for fairgrounds owned by a county or a fair and including applicability provisions. The bill was moved and passed by the vote 24 Aye, 0 Nay and 1 Absent. The bill will move to the house floor as a committee file.

As there was no additional business to come before the committee Representative Gaskill moved to adjourn at 11:12 PM.
