Chairman Sands recognized Representative Vander Linden for opening remarks on [HF 510](#).

An Act relating to enhanced E911 emergency communication. The chair recognized Representative Vander Linden for Amendment 1889. The amendment was moved and passed on short form. The bill as amended was moved and passed by the vote 25 Aye, 0 Nay and 0 Absent. The bill will move to the house floor as a committee file as amended.

Chairman Sands recognized Representative Hagenow for opening remarks on [SF 436](#). An Act relating to the historic preservation and cultural and entertainment district tax credit by modifying the total amount of tax credits that may be issued, the definition of substantial rehabilitation costs, and the qualifications for certain projects. The chair recognized Representative Hagenow for Amendment 1876. The amendment was moved and passed by a vote of 14 Ayes and 11 Nays. The Aye votes were Representatives Sands, Landon, Baltimore, Byrnes, Cownie, Forristall, Grassley, Hagenow, Hein, Maxwell, Moore, Stanerson, Vander Linden and Windschitl. The Nay votes were Representatives Oldson, Forbes, Gaskill, Isenhardt, Kearns, Kelly, Muhlbauer, Riding, Prichard, Stutsman, and Thomas. The bill as amended was moved and passed by the vote 25 Aye, 0 Nay and 0 Absent. The bill will move to the house floor as a Senate File as amended.

As there was no additional business to come before the committee Representative Forristall moved to adjourn at 12:50 PM.
