Chairman Sands recognized Representative Hagenow for opening remarks on [HF 2129](#).

An Act relating to the exclusion from the computation of net income for the individual income tax of net capital gains from the sale of a business.

The chair recognized Representative Hagenow for Amendment 2667. The amendment was moved and passed on short form.

The bill as amended was moved and passed by the vote 15 Aye, 8 Nay, 1 Absent and 1 Rule 76. The nay vote was Representatives Oldson, Forbes, Gaskill, Isenhardt, Kearns, Kelly, Muhlbauer and Stutsman. The bill will move to the house floor as a committee bill as amended.

Chairman Sands recognized Representative Moore for opening remarks on [HF 2149](#). An Act

concerning the excise tax on compressed natural gas and liquefied natural gas used as special fuel.

The chair recognized Representative Moore for Amendment 3185. The amendment was moved and passed on short.

The bill as amended was moved and passed by the vote 24 Aye, 0 Nay and 1 Absent. The bill will move to the house floor as a committee bill as amended.
