Chairman Sands recognized Representative Cownie for opening remarks on <u>HF 2329</u>. An Act relating to and providing for the facilitation of broadband access in unserved or underserved areas of the state, including a property tax exemption for broadband infrastructure, and making appropriations.

The chair recognized Representative Cownie for Amendment 4045. The chair recognized Representative Isenhart for Amendment 4048 to Amendment 4045. The amendment to the amendment was withdrawn. Amendment 4045 was moved by Representative Cownie and passed on short form.

The bill as amended was moved and passed by the vote 16 Aye, 9 Nay and 0 Absent. The nay votes were Representatives Oldson, Kearns, Kelley, Maxwell, Muhlbauer, Prichard, Stutsman, Thomas and Vander Linden. The bill will move to the house floor as a committee bill as amended.

Chairman Sands recognized Representative Windschitl for opening remarks on HF 2430. An

Act providing for an Iowa individual income tax checkoff for the reduction of food insecurity within this state.

The chair recognized Representative Windschitl for Amendment 3964. The amendment was moved and passed on short form.

The bill as amended was moved and passed by the vote 25 Aye, 0 Nay and 0 Absent. The bill will move to the house floor as a committee bill as amended.
