Forristall for opening remarks on <u>HSB 126</u>, a study bill relating to family support programs and provisions including those relating to child support and establishment of paternity. Following discussion of the bill, Rep. Forristall moved <u>HSB 126</u>, a roll call vote was taken. Having received 20 ayes, 0 nays, and 1 excused, Rep. McConkey, <u>HSB 126</u> passed as a committee bill.

The Chair recognized Rep. Heaton for opening remarks on <u>HF 91</u>, a bill for an act relating to the appointment of mental health advocates. Rep. Heaton introduced amendment .252 and it passed by voice vote. Following discussion of the bill, Rep. Heaton moved <u>HF 91</u> as amended, a roll call vote was taken. Having received 20 ayes, 0 nays, and 1 excused, Rep. McConkey, <u>HF 91</u> as amended passed as a committee bill.

The Chair recognized Rep. Gustafson for opening remarks on <u>HF 231</u>, a bill for an act relating to confidential communications between an emergency medical care provider and a patient. Following discussion of the bill, Rep. Gustafson moved <u>HF 231</u>, a roll call vote was taken.

Having received 20 ayes, 0 nays, and 1 excused, Rep. McConkey, <u>HF 231</u> passed as a committee bill.

The Chair recognized Rep. Heaton for opening remarks on <u>HF 263</u>, a bill for an act relating to the development and initial implementation of an inpatient psychiatric bed tracking system by the department of human services. Rep. Heaton introduced amendment .413 and it passed by voice vote. Following discussion of the bill, Rep. Heaton moved <u>HF 263</u> as amended, a roll call vote was taken. Having received 20 ayes, 0 nays, and 1 absent, Rep. McConkey, <u>HF 263</u> as amended passed as a committee bill.
