The meeting was called to order by the Chair, Rep. Linda Miller at 1:00 PM.

Roll was called and all were present, with Rep. Sieck excused.

The minutes from the previous meeting, February 4, 2016 were approved.

Both parties went to caucus at 1:05 PM.

The meeting reconvened at 1:30 PM.

Rep. Miller overturned duties to Rep. Bacon as Chair.

The Chair, Rep. Bacon recognized Rep. Miller for opening remarks on <u>HSB 503</u>, a study bill relating to prescription authority for certain psychologists and making penalties applicable. Rep. Miller introduced an amendment to <u>HSB 503</u> and yielded to questions. Following discussion, Rep. Miller moved the amendment be called to a vote, and <u>HSB 503</u> passed as amended.

Rep. Brown-Powers, Rep. Wessel-Kroeschell and Rep. Heddens followed the amendment with further discussion of <u>HSB 503</u>. Following discussion, a roll call vote was taken. Having received 14 ayes, 6 nays, 1 excused, <u>HSB 503</u> passed as a committee bill.

Rep. Bacon returned duties as Chair to Rep. Miller.

The Chair, Rep. Miller recognized Rep. Best for opening remarks on <u>SF 453</u>, a bill for an act

relating to the board of pharmacy, including nonresident pharmacy and outsourcing facility
licensure, pharmacist supervision of pharmacy technicians, alternate board members, and
enforcement authority. Representative Brown-Powers followed opening remarks with further
discussion. Following discussion, a roll call vote was taken. Having received 19 ayes, 1 nay, 1
excused, <u>SF 453</u> passed as a committee bill.

Seeing no further business, Rep. Best moved that the meeting adjourn. The chair adjourned the meeting at 1:55 PM.
