Having received 12 ayes, 9 nays, 0 excused, [HSB 621](#) passed as a committee bill.

The Chair recognized Rep. Taylor for opening remarks on [HSB 593](#), a study bill relating to the operation of certain schools under the purview of the college student aid commission. Rep. Winckler followed introduction with further discussion. Following discussion, a roll call vote was taken. Having received 21 ayes, 0 nays, 0 excused, [HSB 593](#) passed as a committee bill.

The Chair recognized Rep. Forristall for opening remarks on [HSB 591](#), a study bill relating to public health including public health modernization and boards of health. Rep. Heddens followed introduction with further discussion. Following discussion, a roll call vote was taken. Having received 21 ayes, 0 nays, 0 excused, [HSB 591](#) passed as a committee bill.
