Representative Raecker reconvened the meeting at 10:05 AM and recognized Representative Schulte for opening remarks on HF 626, a bill for an act relating to county and state responsibilities for mental health, mental retardation, and developmental disabilities services for adults and children, making appropriations, and including effective date provisions. Representative Schulte was then recognized for Amendment 626.2676. Questions and discussion followed. Representative Schulte was recognized for closing comments on Amendment 626.2676 and moved the amendment, which passed unanimously, short form. Representative Schulte was then recognized and moved HF 626, which passed, 23-0. HF 626 will move to the House floor as a committee bill.
