Auditor of State Rob Sand today released a report on the Iowa Veterans Home for the year ended June 30, 2022.

The Iowa Commission of Veterans Affairs, which consists of nine members appointed by the Governor and confirmed by the Senate, oversees the conduct and operations of the Iowa Veterans Home.

The Iowa Veterans Home, located in Marshalltown, Iowa, provides long-term health care for Iowa's aging, chronically ill, handicapped veterans and their dependents or surviving spouses. The annualized cost per resident was \$188,491 in fiscal year 2022, a 2.40% increase over the prior year. The average number of residents decreased from 427 in fiscal year 2021 to 399 in fiscal year 2022.

AUDIT FINDINGS:

Sand reported no finding related to the Iowa Veterans Home.


To the Members of the Iowa Veterans Home:
