

2022 IowaPERC (State) Programs & Projects

- 1. <u>Safety Director Project</u> Chapter 101C Act establishing IowaPERC (State). One of the provisions provides for programs/projects to enhance consumer and employee safety, and training. IPGA submitted this request to hire a State Safety & Education Director to facilitate these programs/projects. This project is statewide. \$158,000.00. It is an ongoing project.
- 2. <u>Fire Schools</u> The Iowa Fire Service Training Bureau conducts fire schools around the state of Iowa. This project supplies the propane for the schools. It was statewide. \$5,251.94.
- 3. Regulator Replacement for Eligible LIHEAP Clients Project This project assists LIHEAP clients that are unable to receive propane deliveries due to unsafe regulators on their residential propane system. It provides for a rebate to be applied towards the installation of new regulators on the LIHEAP client installation. This project was offered statewide. 14 rebates were paid out. \$2,475.00.
- 4. <u>Safe High Efficiency Water Heater Rebates</u> This project establishes an incentive program for new high efficiency propane water heaters that are safely installed. This project was statewide. 137 rebates were paid out. \$40,370.00.
- 5. <u>Duty to Warn Brochures</u> Provide Duty to Warn Safety Brochures to the propane marketers to hand out to their propane customers. This project was offered statewide. \$8,421.33.
- 6. <u>Duty to Warn & Don't Get Caught Out of Gas</u> This provides Duty to Warn and Don't Get Caught Out of Gas brochures to LIHEAP Cap Agencies in the state of Iowa to provide to consumers. \$612.00
- 7. Farm Bureau Cookout Contest This project allows IPGA to co-sponsor the Fam Bureau Cookout Contest. Safe Grilling tips are handed out to the contestants and IPGA gives a propane grill to the Youth winner. The project is statewide. \$1,800.
