         Section 1. Section 135.145, subsections 1, 2, and 3, Code
  12 2005, are amended to read as follows:
         1. When the department of public safety or other federal,

1 14 state, or local law enforcement agency learns of a case of a
1 15 <del>reportable</del> disease or health condition, unusual cluster, or a 1 16 suspicious event that may be the cause of a public health
1 17 disaster, the department or agency shall immediately notify
1 18 the department, the administrator of the homeland security and
1 19 emergency management division of the department of public
1 20 defense, the department of agriculture and land stewardship,
1 21 and the department of natural resources as appropriate.
        2. When the department learns of a case of a reportable
  22
1 23 disease or health condition, an unusual cluster, or a
1 24 suspicious event that the department reasonably believes could
  25 potentially be caused by bioterrorism or other act of
  26 terrorism may be the cause of a public health disaster, the
1 27 department shall immediately notify the department of public
1 28 safety, the homeland security and emergency management 1 29 division of the department of public defense, and other
1 30 appropriate federal, state, and local agencies and officials.

         3. Sharing of information on reportable diseases, health
  32 conditions, unusual clusters, or suspicious events between the 33 department and public safety authorities and other
  34 governmental agencies shall be restricted to sharing of only
  35 the information necessary for the prevention, control, and 1 investigation of a public health disaster.
