6	WHEREAS, approximately 280,000 veterans reside in
7	the State of Iowa; and
8	WHEREAS, important public policy issues relating to
9	veterans are often considered and acted upon by state
10	legislatures; and
11	WHEREAS, the current procedures require that the
12	Iowa veterans council and the commission of veterans
13	affairs, in cooperation with one another, present
14	veterans' issues to legislative committees which are
15	often unfamiliar with the specific problems and needs
16	of Iowa veterans; and
17	WHEREAS, 30 other states have established
18	legislative committees to address public policy issues
19	relating to veterans; NOW THEREFORE,
20	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE
	SENATE CONCURRING, That, to facilitate consideration
22	of public policy issues relating to Iowa's veterans,
23	the chairpersons of the Senate and House standing
24	committees on State Government are requested to
25	establish standing subcommittees on veterans affairs
26	and to allow the subcommittees to meet jointly to
27	review veterans issues.
28	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Rules and
	Administration Committee of the Senate is requested to
30	consider recommending to the Senate a change to the
