- 1 Section 1. Section 321.384, Code 2003, is amended to read 2 as follows:
- 3 321.384 WHEN LIGHTED LAMPS REQUIRED.
- 4 1. Every A motor vehicle operated upon a highway within
- 5 the-state, shall display lighted head lamps as provided in
- 6 section 321.415 at any time from sunset to sunrise, at any
- 7 time the motor vehicle's windshield wipers are in continuous
- 8 operation, and at such other times when conditions such as
- 9 fog, snow, sleet, or rain provide insufficient lighting to
- 10 render clearly discernible persons and vehicles on the highway
- 11 at a distance of five hundred feet ahead, shall-display
- 12 lighted-head-lamps-as-provided-in-section-321-415; subject to
- 13 exceptions under this chapter with respect to parked vehicles
- 14 as-hereinafter-stated.
- 2. Whenever A requirement is-hereinafter-declared-as-to
- 16 regarding the distance from which certain lamps and devices
- 17 shall render objects visible or within which such lamps or
- 18 devices shall be visible, -said-provisions shall apply during
- 19 the times stated in subsection 1 of-this-section-upon on a
- 20 straight, level, unlighted highway under normal atmospheric
- 21 conditions unless a different time or condition is expressly
- 22 stated.
- 23 EXPLANATION
- 24 This bill amends Code section 321.384 by requiring a motor
- 25 vehicle to display lighted head lamps at any time when the
- 26 vehicle's wipers are in continuous operation. Due to current
- 27 Code references to Code section 321.384, the bill also
- 28 requires, where applicable, the use of certain lights on other
- 29 types of vehicles while the vehicle's wipers are in operation.
- 30 A violation of these provisions is a simple misdemeanor
- 31 punishable by a scheduled fine of \$20 under Code section
- 32 805.8A.
