1 Section 1. Section 166D.13, subsection 2, Code 2003, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 2. Swine returning from an exhibition to its home herd ~~or~~
4 ~~moved-to-a-purchaser's-herd-following-an-exhibition-or~~
5 ~~consignment-sale~~ must be isolated ~~and-retested-negative~~ for
6 ~~pseudorabies~~ not less than thirty and not more than sixty days
7 after reaching the swine's home herd.

8 2A. Swine moved to a purchaser's herd following an
9 consignment sale must be isolated and retested negative for
10 pseudorabies not less than thirty and not more than sixty days
11 after reaching the swine's destination.

12 EXPLANATION

13 This bill amends Code section 166D.13. Code chapter 166D,
14 which regulates pseudorabies affecting swine, is administered
15 by the department of agriculture and land stewardship. Code
16 section 166D.13 governs the exhibition of swine (e.g., at a
17 fair) and their movement from a home herd to an exhibition and
18 back. One provision in the Code section provides that swine
19 returning from an exhibition must be isolated and retested for
20 pseudorabies between 30 and 60 days after reaching their home
21 herd. The bill removes the retesting requirement.
