1 Section 1. CHILDREN-AT-HOME PROGRAM EXPANSION. There is
2 appropriated from the general fund of the state to the
3 department of human services for the fiscal year beginning
4 July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005, the following amount,
5 or so much thereof as is necessary, to be used for the purpose
6 designated:

7 For expansion of the children-at-home program in order for
8 the program to be available in up to 28 counties in the state:
9 \$ 150,000

10 The moneys appropriated in this section are in addition to
11 any other moneys appropriated or allocated for purposes of the
12 children-at-home program for FY 2004-2005.

13 EXPLANATION

14 This bill makes an appropriation for expansion of the
15 children-at-home program for families with special needs
16 children administered by the department of human services.
17 For several years this program has been funded as an
18 allocation under the annual appropriation to the department
19 for purposes of the family support subsidy program.
20 Currently, the program is available in 14 counties.
