NEW SECTION. 1.19 PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION. 2 If personal identification is required to participate in 3 any activity or to conduct any transaction with the state or a 4 political subdivision of the state, a consular identification 5 card may be accepted as a means of identification. 6 must be issued by a consulate of a foreign nation and the 7 consulate must be located in the United States. A consular 8 identification card may be used for identification purposes 9 only and does not convey a right to receive benefits of any 10 type. The consular identification card shall not be used to 11 12 obtain an Iowa driver's license or a nonoperator's 13 identification card. Sec. 2. Section 321.182, Code 2003, is amended by adding 15 the following new subsection: 16 5. Provide proof of identity as required NEW SUBSECTION. 17 by the department, except that a consular identification card 18 recognized pursuant to section 1.19 shall not be used as proof 19 of identity to obtain an Iowa driver's license or a 20 nonoperator's identification card. 21 EXPLANATION This bill allows a state or local government entity to 22 23 accept a consular identification card as a means of 24 identification.
