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## A BILL FOR

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1 Section 1. Section 514I.2, subsection 6, Code Supplement 2 2003, is amended to read as follows:

6. "Eligible child" means an individual who meets the
4 definition of "child" under 42 C.F.R. § 457.10 and the
5 criteria for participation in the program under section
6 514I.8.

7 Sec. 2. Section 514I.5, subsection 8, paragraph e, Code 8 Supplement 2003, is amended by adding the following new 9 subparagraph:

10 <u>NEW SUBPARAGRAPH</u>. (15) Prenatal and delivery services.
11 Sec. 3. AMENDMENT OF STATE PLAN -- STATE CHILDREN'S HEALTH
12 INSURANCE PROGRAM. The department of human services shall
13 submit an amendment to the state children's health insurance
14 program state plan to the centers for Medicare and Medicaid of
15 the United States department of health and human services to
16 allow the state program to incorporate the provisions of 42
17 C.F.R. § 457.10.

18 Sec. 4. EFFECTIVE DATES.

19 1. The sections of this Act amending sections 514I.2 and 20 514I.5 take effect upon receipt of approval by the department 21 of human services from the centers for Medicare and Medicaid 22 of the United States department of health and human services 23 of the state plan amendment to the state children's health 24 insurance program as described in section 3 of this Act. Upon 25 receipt of the approval, the director of human services shall 26 inform the Iowa Code editor of the date that approval was 27 received.

28 2. The section of this Act requiring the department of 29 human services to submit an amendment to the state children's 30 health insurance program state plan, being deemed of immediate 31 importance, takes effect upon enactment.

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## EXPLANATION

33 This bill relates to eligibility of children under the 34 healthy and well kids in Iowa (hawk-i) program. The bill 35 changes the definition of "eligible child" to include an

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1 individual who meets the definition of "child" under a federal 2 regulation. Under that regulation, 42 C.F.R. § 457.10, 3 "child" means an individual under the age of 19 including the 4 period from conception to birth. The bill also changes the 5 benefits to be provided under the hawk-i program to include 6 prenatal and delivery services.

The bill directs the department of human services to submit 7 8 a state children's health insurance program (SCHIP) state plan 9 amendment to the centers for Medicare and Medicaid services of 10 the United States department of health and human services to 11 allow the state program to incorporate the provision of the 12 federal regulation.

The sections of the bill that amend the definition of 13 14 "eligible child" and add prenatal and delivery services to the 15 benefits package take effect upon receipt of approval of the 16 state plan amendment. The section of the bill directing the 17 department of human services to submit the state plan 18 amendment takes effect upon enactment.

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
