Section 53.40, unnumbered paragraph 2, Code 1 2 2003, is amended to read as follows: 3 Unless the request specifies otherwise, a request for the 4 primary election shall also be considered a request for the 5 general election. In-the-case-of-the-general-election For all 6 elections, request may be made not more than seventy days 7 before the election, for and on behalf of a voter in the armed 8 forces of the United States by a spouse, parent, parent-in-9 law, adult brother, adult sister, or adult child of the voter, 10 residing in the county of the voter's residence.
