- 1 Section 1. Section 321.182, subsection 1, paragraph a,
- 2 Code 2003, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 a. Make application on a form provided by the department
- 4 which shall include the applicant's full name, signature,
- 5 current mailing address, current residential address, date of
- 6 birth, social security number, and physical description
- 7 including sex, height, and eye color. The application form
- 8 shall also include space where the applicant may state the
- 9 applicant's race and ethnicity. The department shall adopt
- 10 rules specifying the racial and ethnic designations the
- ll application shall contain consistent with the uniform crime
- 12 reporting handbook, national incident-based reporting system
- 13 (NIBRS) edition (1992). The application may contain other
- 14 information the department may require by rule. Pursuant to
- 15 procedures established by the department and for an applicant
- 16 who is a foreign national temporarily present in this state,
- 17 the department may waive the requirement that the application
- 18 include the applicant's social security number.

- 21 a. Appearing on the driver's license shall be a
- 22 distinguishing number assigned to the licensee; the licensee's
- 23 full name, date of birth, sex, and residence address; a
- 24 colored photograph; a physical description of the licensee;
- 25 the name of the state; the dates of issuance and expiration;
- 26 and the usual signature of the licensee. The license shall
- 27 identify, in machine-readable format only, the race and
- 28 ethnicity of the licensee if reported on the application for
- 29 the license. The license shall identify the class of vehicle
- 30 the licensee may operate and the applicable endorsements and
- 31 restrictions which the department shall require by rule.
- 32 Sec. 3. Section 321.190, subsection 1, paragraph a, Code
- 33 2003, is amended to read as follows:
- 34 a. The department shall, upon application and payment of
- 35 the required fee, issue to an applicant a nonoperator's

- 1 identification card. To be valid the card shall bear a
- 2 distinguishing number assigned to the card holder, the full
- 3 name, date of birth, sex, residence address, a physical
- 4 description and a colored photograph of the card holder, the
- 5 usual signature of the card holder, and such other information

- 18 renewals, applied for on or after that date.
- 19 EXPLANATION
- 20 This bill provides the means for an applicant for a
- 21 driver's license or nonoperator's identification card to
- 22 report the applicant's race and ethnicity along with other
- 23 information currently required of applicants. The state
- 24 department of transportation is to adopt rules specifying
- 25 racial and ethnic designations to be used on application
- 26 forms. The designations are to be consistent with the
- 27 guidelines contained in the national incident-based reporting
- 28 system (NIBRS) edition of the uniform crime reporting
- 29 handbook. The bill requires that a driver's license or
- 30 nonoperator's identification card shall contain the racial and
- 31 ethnic designations of the licensee or cardholder if reported,
- 32 but only in machine-readable format.
- 33 The bill is effective July 1, 2005, and applies to driver's
- 34 licenses and nonoperator's identification cards applied for on
- 35 or after that date.
