- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 306.8B INTERSTATE BRIDGES -- 2 TRANSFER PROHIBITED.
- 3 Notwithstanding section 306.8 or 306.8A, an agreement for
- 4 transfer of jurisdiction of a primary road to a city may not
- 5 include any portion of a road that is a bridge directly
- 6 connecting Iowa to an adjoining state.
- 7 Sec. 2. PRIOR AGREEMENTS. Notwithstanding section 306.8B,
- 8 as enacted in this Act, a city that has assumed jurisdiction
- 9 and control of a bridge described in that section pursuant to
- 10 an agreement under 2003 Iowa Acts, chapter 144, may elect to
- 11 continue that agreement. If the city does not elect to
- 12 continue the agreement, the city shall return to the treasurer
- 13 of state for reimbursement to the primary road fund any moneys
- 14 apportioned and paid to the city for the fiscal year beginning
- 15 July 1, 2003, for maintenance of the bridge, as determined by
- 16 the state department of transportation.
- 17 Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE AND APPLICABILITY DATES. This Act,
- 18 being deemed of immediate importance, takes effect upon
- 19 enactment and applies retroactively to July 1, 2003, for
- 20 agreements entered into on or after that date.
- 21 EXPLANATION
- 22 This bill provides that an agreement to transfer
- 23 jurisdiction of a primary road to a city may not include
- 24 transfer of jurisdiction of a bridge that provides a direct
- 25 connection between Iowa and an adjoining state. The bill
- 26 applies retroactively to July 1, 2003, and therefore applies
- 27 to agreements identified in the transfer of jurisdiction
- 28 report referred to in Code section 306.8A. A city that has
- 29 assumed jurisdiction of an interstate bridge that is part of a
- 30 road identified in that report pursuant to an agreement
- 31 effective July 1, 2003, may elect to continue the agreement,
- 32 or the city may cancel the agreement and reimburse the primary
- 33 road fund for any moneys received in the 2003 fiscal year for
- 34 maintenance of the bridge.
