SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

1 A Joint Resolution petitioning Congress to propose an amendment to the Constitution of the United States defining marriage as 2 3 the legal union between one man and one woman as husband and 4 wife. WHEREAS, the United States Congress passed the federal Defense 5 6 of Marriage Act in 1996, defining marriage as the legal union 7 between one man and one woman as husband and wife; and WHEREAS, to date 37 states have enacted laws defining marriage 8 9 as between one man and one woman; and WHEREAS, the voters of at least four states -- Alaska, Hawaii, 10 11 Nebraska, and Nevada -- have approved constitutional amendments 12 to define marriage as the legal union between one man and one 13 woman; and WHEREAS, marriage is essential to the foundation of a healthy 14 15 society and the government has a duty to protect that foundation; 16 NOW THEREFORE, 17 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:
