25	Act for fiscal year 2004 will phase out, over 10
26	years, the ban on concurrent receipt of both military
27	retired pay and disability compensation for retirees
28	but only for disabilities rated 50 percent or higher;

1 less than 50 percent should be just as deserving of
 2 relief from the ban on receiving both their military
 3 retired pay and disability compensation that they have
 4 earned; NOW THEREFORE,
      BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, That the United
 6 States Congress be urged to pass, and the President be
 7 urged to sign, legislation to provide full relief for
 8 all eligible veterans from the law that requires a
 9 dollar-for-dollar offset of military retired pay for
10 disability compensation received by certain veterans
11 from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs;

15 Secretary of the Senate, be transmitted to the
16 Honorable George W. Bush, President of the United
