1	SENATE RESOLUTION NO.
2	BY WARNSTADT
3	A Resolution urging the United States Department of
4	Labor to continue overtime protection for veterans
5	who receive specialized military training.
6	WHEREAS, many veterans currently working in
7	professional fields are entitled to overtime
8	protection because they lack a specialized degree
9	necessary to be considered a "professional employee"
10	as defined under current United States Department of
L1	Labor regulations; and
L 2	WHEREAS, proposed Department of Labor regulations
13	would deny overtime protection to many veterans who
L 4	have received specialized military training by
15	treating the military training as equivalent to a
16	professional degree; and
17	WHEREAS, veterans who lose overtime protection
18	would no longer be entitled to additional compensation
19	for the overtime hours they work and veterans who rely
20	on overtime pay for any significant part of their
21	income would suffer a reduction in their standard of
22	living; and
23	WHEREAS, even though such training has
24	traditionally been a recruitment incentive, the
25	proposed regulations could actually discourage
26	military recruitment because potential recruits may
27	expect that the training and experience acquired
28	through military service would make them ineligible
29	for overtime pay; NOW THEREFORE,
