A Resolution designating the week of May 4, 2003,

National Correctional Officers and Employees Week.

WHEREAS, the operation of correctional facilities represents a crucial component of the criminal justice system of the United States; and

WHEREAS, correctional personnel play a vital role in protecting the rights of the public to be

safeguarded from criminal activity; and

WHEREAS, correctional personnel are responsible for the care, custody, and dignity of persons charged to their care; and

WHEREAS, correctional personnel work under demanding circumstances and face danger in their daily work lives; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, That the Senate designates the week beginning May 4, 2003, "National Correctional Officers and Employees Week"; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Senate requests that the President of the United States issue a proclamation calling upon the people of the United States to observe National Correctional Officers and Employees Week with appropriate ceremonies and activities.
