#### A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to requirements for consumer-directed attendant

2 care provided under a medical assistance home and community-

3 based services waiver.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 249A.32, Code 2005, is amended to read
- 2 as follows:
- 3 249A.32 MEDICAL ASSISTANCE HOME AND COMMUNITY-BASED
- 4 SERVICES WAIVERS -- CONSUMER-DIRECTED ATTENDANT CARE --
- 5 PROVIDER VERIFICATION -- TERMINATION OF CONTRACT.
- 6 1. a. A person who applies to the department for approval
- 7 as a consumer-directed attendant care provider shall provide
- 8 proof of any training, certification, licensing, or
- 9 supervision required for the type of service that the
- 10 applicant would provide under a contract with a consumer.
- 11 Prior to approval and issuance of a provider number to a
- 12 consumer-directed attendant care provider applicant, the
- 13 <u>department shall verify the proof provided.</u>
- b. At the time of entering into a contract for the
- 15 provision of consumer-directed attendant care, the consumer,
- 16 with the assistance of the case manager, shall verify that the
- 17 consumer-directed attendant care provider has the requisite
- 18 training, certification, licensing, or supervision necessary
- 19 to provide the care specified in the contract.
- 20 2. The case manager shall periodically review with the
- 21 consumer the narrative record of the care provided by the
- 22 consumer-directed attendant care provider to determine
- 23 compliance with the contract.
- 24 1. 3. A case manager for-a-medical-assistance-home-and
- 25 community-based-services-waiver may terminate the contract of
- 26 a person providing consumer-directed attendant care services
- 27 to whom payment is being made for provision of such services
- 28 under the waiver if the case manager determines that the
- 29 person has breached the contract by not providing the services
- 30 agreed to under the contract.
- 31 2: 4. For the purposes of this section, "consumer" and
- 32 "waiver" mean consumer and waiver as defined in section
- 33 249A.29 and "narrative record" means the provider's record of
- 34 services provided to the consumer as specified in the contract
- 35 between the consumer and provider, and for which the provider

### 1 bills the department for payment under a waiver. EXPLANATION 2 This bill provides requirements for the provision of 4 consumer-directed attendant care under a medical assistance 5 home and community-based services waiver. The bill requires a 6 consumer-directed attendant care provider applicant to provide 7 proof of any training, certification, licensing, or 8 supervision required for the type of service that the 9 applicant would provide under a contract with a consumer. 10 Additionally, the bill requires the department of human 11 services, prior to approval of and issuance of a provider 12 number to a consumer-directed attendant care provider 13 applicant, to verify the proof provided. The bill provides 14 that at the time of entering into a contract for the provision 15 of consumer-directed attendant care, the consumer, with the 16 assistance of the case manager, is to verify that the 17 consumer-directed attendant care provider has the requisite 18 training, certification, licensing, or supervision necessary 19 to provide the care specified in the contract. The bill requires the case manager to periodically review 21 with the consumer the narrative record of the care provided by 22 the consumer-directed attendant care provider to determine 23 compliance with the contract. 24 The bill defines "narrative record" as the provider's 25 record of services provided as specified in the contract 26 between the consumer and provider and for which the provider 27 bills the department for payment under a waiver. 28 29 30 31 32 33 34
