## A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to voluntary annexation and municipal services requirements.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 368.7B MUNICIPAL SERVICES. 1. The notice of application for annexation and public 3 hearing that is required in section 368.7 shall include 4 information from the annexing city as follows: a. A description of existing municipal services, including 6 but not limited to water supply, sewage disposal, and fire and police protection provided to the territory to be annexed. 8 b. A plan for extending municipal services to be provided 9 by the annexing city to the annexed territory within three 1 1 10 years of July 1 of the fiscal year in which city taxes are 11 first collected against property in the annexed territory.
12 2. Prior to expiration of the three=year period 1 12 1 13 established in this section, the annexing city shall submit a 1 14 report to the city development board describing the status of 1 15 the provision of municipal services identified in the plan. 1 16 If the city fails to provide municipal services, or fails to 1 17 show substantial and continuing progress in providing 18 municipal services to the annexed territory, the board may 1 19 initiate proceedings to sever the annexed territory from the 1 20 city. The board shall notify the city of the severance 21 proceedings and shall hold a public hearing on the proposed 22 severance. The board shall give notice of the hearing in the 1 23 same manner as required in section 368.7. The board may order 24 severance of all or a portion of the territory and the order 25 to sever is not subject to approval at an election. A city 1 26 may request that the board allow up to an additional three 1 27 years to provide municipal services if good cause is shown. 28 As an alternative to severance of the territory, the board may 29 impose a moratorium on additional annexation by the city until

31 services to the annexed territory. EXPLANATION

33 This bill applies the municipal services requirements of 34 involuntary annexations to voluntary annexations. Pursuant to 35 Code section 368.7, the city is required to give notice of an 1 application for voluntary annexation and public hearing. The 2 bill requires that this notice provide information from the 3 annexing city regarding existing and future municipal 4 services.

The annexing city must have a plan for extending municipal 6 services to an annexed territory within three years of July 1 7 of the fiscal year in which city taxes are first collected 8 against property in the annexed territory. The bill requires 9 the city to report to the city development board on the city's 10 progress in providing municipal services as identified in the 2 10 progress in providing municipal services as identified in the 2 11 plan.
