There is appropriated from the general fund of the 3 state to the department of agriculture and land stewardship 4 for the designated fiscal years the following amounts, or so 5 much thereof as is necessary, to provide grants to schools as 6 part of the farm=to=school program as provided in chapter 7 190A: 8 a. For the fiscal year beginning out 1, 2000, 9 June 30, 2009, to provide grants of one thousand dollars each 1 1 10 to fifty schools: 11\$ 50,00 12 b. For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2009, and ending 1 12 1 13 June 30, 2010, to provide grants of five hundred dollars each 1 14 to fifty schools: 1 15\$ 25,00 1 16 2. The grants shall be used to provide schools with fresh 1 17 and minimally processed food produced by Iowa farmers or 1 18 minimally processed food derived from commodities produced by 1 19 Iowa farmers for inclusion in school meals and snacks, 1 20 encourage children to develop healthy eating habits, and 1 21 provide Iowa farmers access to consumer markets. 1 22 3. An elementary or secondary public or nonpublic school 1 23 in this state is eligible to participate in the program. A 1 24 school shall submit an application for a grant as provided by 25 the department. The farm=to=school council created in section 1 26 190A.2 shall award the grants. 4. The department of agriculture and land stewardship 1 27 1 28 shall cooperate with the department of education in 29 administering this section. EXPLANATION 1 31 This bill appropriates moneys to the department of agriculture and land stewardship for FY 2008=2009 and FY 1 33 2009=2010 to support the farm=to=school program in Code 34 chapter 190A enacted by the general assembly in 2007 to 35 encourage and promote the purchase of locally and regionally 1 produced or processed food produced by Iowa farmers in order 2 to improve child nutrition and strengthen local and regional 2 3 farm economies. The bill provides for the allocation of grants to provide 5 schools with fresh and minimally processed food for inclusion 6 in school meals and snacks, encourage children to develop 7 healthy eating habits, and provide Iowa farmers access to 8 consumer markets. The allocations are to be made by the 9 farm=to=school council established in Code section 190A.2. 2 10 The department of agriculture and land stewardship is required 2 11 to cooperate with the department of education in administering 2 12 the bill.
