EXPLANATION This bill repeals Code section 321.210C, which requires a 4 probation period for certain drivers following a period of 1 5 license suspension, revocation, or bar. The Code section 6 requires that a person who loses the person's driver's license 7 or operating privileges as a result of a moving traffic 8 violation or an operating=while=intoxicated conviction must 9 complete a 12=month probation period beginning immediately

1 10 after the end of the period of suspension, revocation, or bar. 1 11 If the person is convicted of another moving traffic violation 1 12 which occurred during the probation period, the department may 1 13 suspend the person's license or operating privileges for an 1 14 additional period equal in duration to the original period of 1 15 suspension, revocation, or bar, or for one year, whichever is
