 - a. Perform or attempt to perform human cloning.
 - b. Participate in performing or in an attempt to perform human cloning.
 - c. Transfer or receive a cloned human embryo for any 3 purpose.
 - d. Transfer or receive, in whole or in part, any oocyte, human embryo, fetus, or human somatic cell, for the purpose of 6 human cloning.
- This section shall not restrict areas of scientific 8 research not specifically prohibited, including in vitro 9 fertilization; the administration of fertility=enhancing 2 10 drugs; or research in the use of nuclear transfer or other 2 11 cloning techniques to produce molecules, deoxyribonucleic 2 12 acid, tissues, organs, plants, animals other than humans, or

5. A person who violates this section and who is licensed 2 23 pursuant to chapter 148, 150, or 150A is subject to revocation 2 24 of the person's license.

6. A violation of this section is grounds for denial of an 2 26 application for, denial of renewal of, or revocation of any 27 license, permit, certification, or any other form of 28 permission required to practice or engage in any trade, 2 29 occupation, or profession regulated by the state. Sec. 5. Chapter 707C, Code Supplement 2007, is repealed.

31 EXPLANATION 32 This bill relates to the use of products of human 33 reproduction for the purposes of human cloning and is the same 34 as former Code chapter 707B, which was repealed in 2007 Iowa 35 Acts, chapter 6.

The bill defines terms used in the bill. 2 prohibits a person from knowingly or intentionally: performing or attempt to perform human cloning; participating 4 in performing or in an attempt to perform human cloning; 5 transferring or receiving a cloned human embryo for any 6 purpose; or transferring or receiving, in whole or in part, 7 any oocyte, human embryo, fetus, or human somatic cell, for 8 the purpose of human cloning.

9 The bill provides that it is not the intent of the bill to 10 restrict areas of scientific research not specifically 3 11 prohibited, including in vitro fertilization; the 3 12 administration of fertility=enhancing drugs; or research in 13 the use of nuclear transfer or other cloning techniques to 3 14 produce molecules, deoxyribonucleic acid, tissues, organs, 3 15 plants, animals other than humans, or cells other than human 16 embryos.

3 17 Under the bill, a person who performs or attempts to 3 18 perform human cloning or who participates in performing or in 19 an attempt to perform human cloning is guilty of a class "C" 20 felony. A class "C" felony is punishable by confinement for 3 21 no more than 10 years and a fine of at least \$1,000 but not 22 more than \$10,000. A person who transfers or receives a 23 cloned human embryo for any purpose or who transfers or 3 24 receives, in whole or in part, any oocyte, human embryo, 3 25 fetus, or human somatic cell, for the purpose of human cloning 26 is guilty of an aggravated misdemeanor. An aggravated 27 misdemeanor is punishable by confinement for no more than two 3 28 years and a fine of at least \$625 but not more than \$6,250. 29 Additionally, a person who violates the provisions of the bill 3 30 in a manner that results in a pecuniary gain to the person is 31 subject to a civil penalty in an amount that is twice the 32 amount of the gross gain. A person who violates the 33 provisions of the bill who is licensed in the practice of 34 medicine and surgery, osteopathy, or osteopathic medicine and 35 surgery is subject to revocation of the person's license. 1 violation of the bill is also grounds for denial of an 2 application for, denial of renewal of, or revocation of any 3 license, permit, certification, or any other form of 4 permission required to practice or engage in any trade,

5 occupation, or profession regulated by the state.
6 The bill repeals Code chapter 707C, relating to human stem 7 cell research and cloning.
