1 12 training agency under contract with Iowa Workforce
1 13 Development, had paid $1.8 million in inflated 1 14 salaries to three executives from July 2003 to

         WHEREAS, in the ensuing months allegations and
1 17 rumors grew and both local and state officials
1 18 resigned their offices in the wake of the scandal; and
  19 WHEREAS, ongoing news relating to this scandal 20 undermined Iowans' confidence in all levels of their
