Section 1. Section 85.35, Code 2007, is amended by adding 2 the following new subsection:

<u>NEW SUBSECTION</u>. 5A. The parties to any settlement made 4 pursuant to this section may agree that the employee has the 5 right to benefits pursuant to section 85.27 under such terms 6 and conditions as agreed to by the parties in the settlement, 7 for a specified period of time after the settlement has been 8 approved by the workers' compensation commissioner. that specified period of time, the commissioner shall have jurisdiction of the settlement for the purpose of adjudicating 9 10 1 11 the employee's entitlement to benefits provided for in section 1 12 85.27 as agreed upon in the settlement.

Sec. 2. Section 85.65A, subsection 5, Code 2007, is 1 14 amended by striking the subsection.

Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of 1 16 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment. EXPLANATION

This bill relates to provisions for continued medically 1 19 related benefits in certain settlements of workers' 20 compensation claims.

The bill amends Code section 85.35 by allowing parties to a 1 22 settlement for workers' compensation benefits to agree that 23 the employee has the right to medically related benefits 24 pursuant to Code section 85.27 under such terms and conditions 1 25 as agreed to by the parties in the settlement, for a specified 26 period of time after the settlement has been approved by the workers' compensation commissioner. During the specified 1 28 period of time, the workers' compensation commissioner retains 1 29 jurisdiction of the settlement for the purpose of adjudicating 30 the employee's entitlement to the medically related benefits, 31 as agreed upon in the settlement.

The bill strikes Code section 85.65A(5) which repeals this 33 section on July 1, 2008. Code section 85.65A allows 34 imposition of a surcharge on employers to fund the workers'

35 compensation second injury fund. The bill is effective upon
