2 2		without a license and is eligible to obtain special licenses to hunt deer and wild turkey on that farm unit.
2	15^{14}	The bill allows any landowner or family member of a
2	-	landowner, even a nonresident, to hunt, fish, and trap, on the
	17	farm unit without a license and to obtain special deer and
2		turkey hunting licenses for use only on the farm unit. The
2	19	bill also changes the definition of "owner" of a farm unit to
2	20	include a person who owns a farm unit and employs a farm
