## A BILL FOR

An Act requiring the commissioner of insurance to apply any
minimum health care benefits required by federal law to

3 health care coverage regulated by the state.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. HEALTH CARE COVERAGE — FEDERAL REQUIREMENTS.
The commissioner of insurance shall maintain an ongoing effort
to monitor federal law and federal health reform efforts that
require health care coverage to provide, at a minimum, a core
set of benefits covering essential health care services.
The commissioner, by rule, shall make any such federal
requirements, including requirements established by the United
States secretary of health and human services or any other
agency, board, or commission under authority granted by federal
legislation, the minimum requirements for health care coverage
that is regulated by state law.

## EXPLANATION

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13 This bill requires the commissioner of insurance to monitor 14 federal law and federal health reform efforts which contain 15 minimum requirements that health care coverage provide a core 16 set of benefits covering essential health care services. The 17 commissioner, by rule, is required to make any such federal 18 minimum requirements applicable to health care coverage that is 19 regulated by the state.

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
