| 4 | All appointive boards, commissions, committees ${ }_{+}$and |
| 5 | councils of the state or of a political subdivision of the |
| 6 | state, that are established by the Code $\perp^{\text {if }}$ if not otherwise |
| 7 | provided by law ${ }_{ \pm}$shall be gender balanced. No person shall be |
| 8 | appointed or reappointed to any board, commission, committee, |
|  | or council established by the Code if that appointment or |
| 10 | reappointment would cause the number of members of the board, |
| 11 | commission, committee, or council of one gender to be greater |
| 12 | than one=half the membership of the board, commission, |

| 14 | committee, or council is composed of an odd number of members. |

| 26 | EXPLANATION |
| 27 | This bill requires appointive boards, commissions, |
| 28 | committees, and councils of a political subdivision of the |
| 29 | state that are established by the Iowa Code to be gender |
| 30 | balanced. Current law only applies the gender balance |
| 31 | requirement to state boards, commissions, committees, and |
| 32 | councils. The bill provides that the gender balance |
| 33 | requirement for political subdivisions applies beginning on |
| 34 | and after January 1, 2012. |
