1 An Act providing a sales tax exemption from the sale of new and used textbooks for postsecondary educational institution

Section 1. Section 423.3, Code 2009, is amended by adding 2 the following new subsection:

3 <u>NEW SUBSECTION</u>. 95. a. The sales price from the sale of 4 new and used textbooks for use in attending a postsecondary 5 educational institution.

b. For purposes of this subsection:(1) "Postsecondary educational institution" means an 8 accredited higher education institution, as defined in section 9 261.92, an Iowa community college, a postsecondary educational 10 institution under the control of the state board of regents, a 1 11 school of cosmetology arts and sciences licensed under chapter 1 12 157, or a barber school licensed under chapter 158.

(2) "Textbooks" means books and other printed materials 1 14 used in attending a postsecondary educational institution in

1 15 this state. 1 16

- c. Postsecondary educational institutions are required to 17 provide the titles of required and recommended textbooks for 1 18 all courses and the corresponding authors, publishers, and 1 19 international standard book numbers for such textbooks on the 20 postsecondary educational institution's internet website for 21 access to all booksellers and all students. The department of 1 22 education shall designate the format by which the textbook 23 information shall be provided.
- d. In order to receive the sales tax exemption, a person 1 25 is required to show a current official identification card 26 from a postsecondary educational institution and either the 27 purchaser or the bookseller must show that the textbooks 28 intended to be purchased are on a list of textbooks provided 1 29 by a postsecondary educational institution under paragraph 30 "c".

EXPLANATION

This bill provides a sales tax exemption from the sale of 33 textbooks used in attending a public or private Iowa 34 postsecondary educational institution, including licensed 35 cosmetology and barber schools. "Textbooks" is defined as 1 books and other printed materials.

2 Postsecondary educational institutions are required to 3 provide the titles of textbooks for all courses and the 4 authors, publishers, and corresponding international standard 5 book numbers for the textbooks on the institution's internet 6 website in order for all booksellers and students to have 7 access to the information. The department of education is 8 required to provide the format in which the textbook

9 information must be provided.
10 In order to receive the sales tax exemption, a person must 2 10 2 11 show a current official identification card from a

2 12 postsecondary educational institution and either the purchaser
