Notwithstanding the total amount of proceeds distributed pursuant to section 249J.24, subsection 6, paragraph "a", and notwithstanding the amount collected and distributed for deposit in the IowaCare account pursuant to section 249J.24, subsection 6, paragraph "a", subparagraph (2), the first \$21,000,000 in proceeds collected pursuant to section 347.7 between January 1, 2009, and June 30, 2009, shall be distributed to the treasurer of state for deposit in the IowaCare account and collections during this time period in excess of \$21,000,000 shall be distributed to the acute care teaching hospital identified in section 249J.24, subsection 6. Sec 2. EFFECTIVE DATE == RETROACTIVITY. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment and is retroactively applicable to January 1, 2009. EXPLANATION This bill provides that notwithstanding the amounts specified in law regarding the total (\$34 million) and biannual amounts (\$17 million) of the county hospital tax levy specified under the IowaCare program for distribution to the treasurer of state for deposit in the IowaCare account, the county treasurer of a county with a population over 350,000 (Polk) is required to distribute \$21 million of the amount collected between January 1, 2009, and June 30, 2009, to the treasurer of state for deposit in the IowaCare account, with any amount in excess of the \$21 million being distributed to the publicly owned acute care teaching hospital in such county (Broadlawns medical center).
