A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act authorizing registered nurses and physician assistants
- 2 to order respiratory therapy.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 148C.4, subsection 1, Code 2011, is
2 amended to read as follows:

1. A physician assistant may perform medical services when the services are rendered under the supervision of a physician. A physician assistant student may perform medical services when the services are rendered within the scope of an approved program. For the purposes of this section, "medical services when the services are rendered under the supervision of a physician" includes making:

10 <u>a. Making</u> a pronouncement of death for a patient whose death 11 is anticipated if the death occurs in a licensed hospital, a 12 licensed health care facility, a Medicare-certified home health 13 agency, or a Medicare-certified hospice program or facility, 14 with notice of the death to a physician and in accordance with 15 the directions of a physician.

16 b. Ordering respiratory therapy.

17 Sec. 2. Section 152.1, subsection 6, Code 2011, is amended 18 to read as follows:

19 6. The *practice of the profession of a registered nurse*"
20 means the practice of a natural person who is licensed by the
21 board to do all of the following:

a. Formulate nursing diagnosis and conduct nursing treatment
of human responses to actual or potential health problems
through services, such as case finding, referral, health
teaching, health counseling, and care provision which is
supportive to or restorative of life and well-being.

b. Execute regimen prescribed by a physician, an advancedregistered nurse practitioner, or a physician assistant.

29 c. Supervise and teach other personnel in the performance of 30 activities relating to nursing care.

31 d. Perform additional acts or nursing specialties which 32 require education and training under emergency or other 33 conditions which are recognized by the medical and nursing 34 professions and are approved by the board as being proper to be 35 performed by a registered nurse.

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1 e. Make the pronouncement of death for a patient whose death 2 is anticipated if the death occurs in a licensed hospital, a 3 licensed health care facility, a Medicare-certified home health 4 agency, a Medicare-certified hospice program or facility, an 5 assisted living facility, or a residential care facility, with 6 notice of the death to a physician and in accordance with any 7 directions of a physician.

8 f. Order respiratory therapy.

9 *f. g.* Apply to the abilities enumerated in paragraphs 10 "a" through "e" "f" of this subsection scientific principles, 11 including the principles of nursing skills and of biological, 12 physical, and psychosocial sciences.

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EXPLANATION

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14 This bill authorizes registered nurses and physician 15 assistants to order respiratory therapy.
